NOTICE TO BUYER:

Forfeiture clause: "If payment is in arrears and the instrument is left at school, *The Repair Shop* legally has the right to take possession of the instrument." The buyer consents to *The Repair Shop* obtaining credit information from a credit reporting agency. This sales agreement will expire every month from the start date unless payment is received on the due date, throughout the life of the agreement. ***There are no refunds for early returns.***

MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The Repair Shop will maintain the instrument in good playing condition at no additional cost. This specifically does **NOT** cover dents, scratches and cosmetic flaws that have no effect on the playing condition of the instrument. ***The buyer will be responsible for these charges.*** Also excluded are expendable items such as reeds, swabs and lubricants. This does not include lost parts, but an exchange will be made if a mouthpiece breaks. All repairs and maintenance must be made by *The Repair Shop*. ***Do not attempt any repairs on your own.***

INSTRUMENT REPLACEMENT PLAN:

The Repair Shop will offer no insurance coverage for replacement of this instrument in case of theft or fire. The buyer agrees to provide coverage through an insurance plan of their own. In the case of loss by theft or fire, the buyer is responsible for paying the balance owed on the instrument to *The Repair Shop*.

TERMS:

Title and right of possession of the instrument shall remain with *The Repair Shop* until total payments equal the total value (includes sales tax) of the instrument. At that time ownership will be transferred to the buyer. If monthly payments are not paid when due, *The Repair Shop* shall have the right to take possession of the instrument. The buyer agrees not to sell, mortgage, remove from the state, or otherwise dispose of this instrument during the purchase period. The buyer understands that this agreement may be terminated if the buyer moves and fails to provide *The Repair Shop* with a new address or if the student changes schools. If this agreement is terminated, the purchaser will return the instrument and any accessories, in good condition, to *The Repair Shop* immediately.

INSTRUMENT EXCHANGE POLICY:

All monies paid at the 5% per month rate shall apply in full toward the purchase price of the original instrument or one of greater value when available. *The Repair Shop* will offer to help with the search of an upgrade instrument if the buyer wishes.

PAST-DUE ACCOUNTS:

Using the information provided on the Sales Agreement, *The Repair Shop* will debit the credit/debit card account on the date indicated. In the event the buyer wants to change the account information, the buyer is responsible for notifying *The Repair Shop* at least 10 days prior to due date of all proper account information to process any auto debit payments. Invalid information and insufficient funds will cause the buyer's account to be subject to nonsufficient fees of \$20.00. If the buyer's account falls 3 months into arrears, it will be forwarded to a collection agency, and the buyer will be responsible for the full amount due on the instrument plus any additional collection fees incurred. In the event that *The Repair Shop* is compelled to incur any expense in maintaining or defending any action or proceeding instituted by reason of any default on the signer, such expense shall be the responsibility of the signer.

CUSTOMER'S RIGHT TO CANCEL:

The buyer may cancel this agreement by mailing a written notice to ***The Repair Shop, 2321 E. Mulberry, Suite 4, Fort Collins, CO 80524*** or via email at trshopjks@aol.com. Payments will continue to be deducted from the account provided until the instrument is returned to *The Repair Shop*. School Music Educators are not agents of *The Repair Shop*.
